Activity Name: Make Blueprints

Study: Buildings

Objective for Learning: Obj. 33



The following supplies are needed for this activity:

Paper: Long light blue
1 craft stick (for lines)

Instructions:

1. Explain what a blueprint is. It's several lines short and long, rectangles, squares, circles, etc... that connects to help frame the structure of a building.
2. Have your child review different buildings.
3. Have your child pick a building he or she would like to blueprint.
4. Ask why, how, what questions.
5. Decide on a name for your blueprint. Write it on the top of the blueprint.
6. See the second link below for an example of a blueprint.
7. Have your child use a pencil to draw lines on your paper to form his or her blueprint.
8. Complete and send a picture to your teacher.
