

## Activity Instructions

Activity Name: Tree Count

Study: Trees

Objective for Learning: 20a, 17a, 17b, 18a, 18c



The following supplies are needed for this activity:  
crayons, scissors, a book

### Instructions:

- Listen to the book.
- Show your child the front cover, spine, and back of the book you have at home.
- Ask your child what they remember seeing in the book.
- Show them pictures of the trunk, maple seeds, pecans, knot hole, Aspen leaves, Dogwood buds, pinecones, apples, walnuts, and magnolia blossoms.
- Have them count the items with you.
- Let your child color the Leaves Counting book. Cut the pages in half and staple to book together so your child can practice flipping through the pages.
- Have your child practice counting the leaves and telling you the colors of the leaves, look through the book for leaves that are the same and different. Talk about how they are the same or different.
