

## Activity Instructions

Activity Name: Simple Patterns

Study: Buildings

Objective for Learning: Obj: 23



The following supplies are needed for this activity:

Paper: red, blue

Scissors

Instructions:

1. Parents cut out a rectangle which will represent a door.
2. Next, cut out a square which will represent a window.
3. Talk about scissor safety. Help your child cut out 4 rectangles/doors.
4. Help your child cut out 4 squares/windows.
5. Discuss the differences of a rectangle and a square.
6. Have your child count each window and door touching each one w/his or her fingers.
7. Tell your child you want them to make a simple red-window/blue-door pattern.
8. Ask your child which comes next window or a door. It might take some practice for your child to understand. Just keep practicing.
