

Activity Instructions

Activity Name: Name Recognition

Study: Beginning of the Year

Objective for Learning: 15, 16, 8



The following supplies are needed for this activity:

- 1. Construction paper or notebook paper
- 2. Markers or pencils
- 3. Scissors
- 4. Clear tape

Instructions:

Step 1: Write your child's name on a piece of paper nice and big

Step2: Add two other names with your child's name using the beginning letter of your child's first name, then have him/her choose which one is their name.

Step 3: Write your child's name out, make sure the letters are not close together, then cut each letter out, using your child's name that you wrote out big, have your child match the letters that you have cut out to the letters of his/her first name that you wrote out on big paper.

Step 4: You can write your child's first name out on a piece of paper nice and big, then you can take some clear tape and put it over their name, then you can have your child trace over the letters in their name by using a marker.
