

Activity Instructions

Activity Name: Pass the Message

Study: Buildings

Objective for Learning: Obj: 8-10



The following supplies are needed for this activity:

2 paper cups
long string
markers
crayons
tape

Instructions:

1. Gather your materials. Tell your child we going to make a pretend telephone.
2. Ask your child how does the telephone work at your house?
3. Have your child color the 2 cups.
4. Next, put a small hole in the bottom of your cups with a pencil.
5. Insert the string in the bottom of the two cups.
6. Tape the string in the inside of the cup down w/tape.
7. Now, you are ready to pass a message. Talk into the cup and see if you the person can hear and understand you.
8. Have a conversation about how you made the message cups.
9. Continue to engage in conversation with your child.
10. To extend learning, ask your child to trace the top of the cup and make circles.
11. Send a picture to your child teacher w/your message cup.
