

Activity Instructions

Activity Name: Apple Tree Counting

Study: Tree

Objective for Learning: 7a, 20a, 20b, 20c, 22c



The following supplies are needed for this activity:

Clothes pins
Tree Counting Handouts
Red tissue paper
Glue
Crayons or Markers

Instructions:

- Tear tissue paper into small pieces
- Let your child ball up the red tissue paper to make apples
- Your child can color the tree tops green
- Using the tree counting worksheets - glue one ball of tissue (1 apple) on the 1 one treetop
- Glue two balls of tissue (2 apples) on the 2 two treetop
- Glue three balls of tissue (3 apples) on the 2 three treetop
- Glue on four balls of tissue (4 apples) on the 4 four treetop
- Glue on five balls of tissue (5 apples) on the 5 five treetop
- Count the apples on each tree and ask your child to find the clothes pin with the matching number and clip it to the bottom of the tree.

If this is an activity you would like to repeat you can skip the step of gluing the apples on the trees and just let your child practice counting repeatedly and matching the numbers.
