

Activity Instructions

Activity Name: Sink or Float

Study: Buildings

Objective for Learning: Obj:24 & 20a



The following supplies are needed for this activity:
Markers, paper, pencil, big cup or bowl, sinking or floating items from around the house

Instructions:

1. Tell your child that we are going to do a sink or float experiment.
2. Ask your child to walk around the house and find some small objects that can get wet.
3. Parents on your paper make two columns one for sinking items and one for floating items.
4. Pour the water into the cup or bowl. Leave some room at the top.
5. Have the child pick an item and place it into the cup or bowl of water?
6. What happen to the item? Why did it float or sink?
7. Parents write down the name of the item in the correct column. (float/sink)
8. Continue, until you have finished w/all your items.
9. Next, count how many you have in each column.
10. Write the numbers at the bottom of the columns.
11. Send a picture to your teacher.
