

## Activity Instructions

Activity Name: ABC

Study: The First 6 Weeks

Objective for Learning: Obj.16a



The following supplies are needed for this activity:

ABC Flash Card  
Found items

### Instructions:

One of the objectives for learning and development we will be assessing this year is demonstrates knowledge of the alphabet, identifies and names letters. At this point in the year we will be assessing what your child already knows so we can work together to identify what his/her personal learning goal will be.

1. Show your child the video
2. Encourage them to identify the objects in each picture
3. If your child knows the letters start talking to them about the sound of each letter
4. Write letters on paper and have your child try to find the matching letter in their flashcards.
5. Encourage your child to name the letter
6. Write you child's name on a piece of paper and have them find the flashcards with matching letters. Talk about the sound each letter makes. B is for Bus and B is Brian.
7. Get a book, or a box of cereal – Point to a letter on the box and ask your child to find the flashcard with the same letter.

In the beginning limit these games to shorter words and only provide 5 or 6 flashcards. As your child demonstrates they know more letters you can expand the flash card deck and the size of the words. If your child is 3 you may want to start with 3 letter words. If your child is 4 and has an expansive vocabulary and letter knowledge challenge them with 4 or 5 letter words.

Make observations about what your child says, what letters they know and which ones they struggle with. Share with your child's teacher so we can use the data to structure our individualized learning plan for your child.
