Activity Name: Building with Rocks

Study: Buildings

Objective for Learning: Obj: 28



The following supplies are needed for this activity:

Rocks
Paper
Pencil

Instructions:

1. Go on a nature walk to find different kinds of rocks.
2. Make a chart on your paper.
3. Put a rock on the top of your paper. Write on the paper the words shiny, smooth, rough, color. (see second link below for example)
4. Compare the colors, texture, weight: light or heavy. Record you answers on your paper.
5. Do you think you can stack the rocks on top of each other?
6. Have your child describe how the rocks are the same or different.
7. Count how many rocks you found.
8. Classify your rocks from smallest to biggest.
9. Continue to ask questions to expand your child's learning.
10. Send a picture of your child completing the activity.
