

Activity Instructions

Activity Name: Number Tile

Study: Buildings

Objective for Learning: Obj: 20



The following supplies are needed for this activity:

Paper, pencil or markers

Instructions:

1. Tell your child that we are going to match items to the number.
2. Find some small object to use for counting.
3. Parent write the numbers 1, 2, 3 medium size on the top part of the paper. Space the numbers out. You will need room to place the objects on the number square.
4. At the bottom, write the number 4, 5, 6 medium size.
5. Draw lines to separate the numbers. You should have 6 boxes.
6. For the number 1 make 1 dot under the number. Same for the number 2 make 2 dots. Same for number 3 make 3 dots. Continue with 4, 5, and 6.
7. Now, it is time to match and count.
8. Have your child count out the correct number of items for the correct number.
9. To extend learning make a new number tile with higher numbers.
