Activity Name: The Acorn and the Oak Tree?

Study: Trees

Objective for Learning: 11d, 11e, 12a, 12b, 12, 9b , 9c, 10a, 10b

Instructions:

- Listen to the story “The Acorn and the Oak Tree”
- Show your child the 4 steps of the oak tree life cycle and see if they can recall any of the events from the story.
- Cut out the picture and words with or for your child
- Provide them with a paper plate or piece of paper divided into 4 sections. Write the numbers 1 – 4 on each section,
- Have them practice getting the life cycle in the proper order and when they have it down let them glue the stages into the proper section.



- To expand on their learning take them outside and see if you can find an acorn, a seedling, a young oak tree (sapling), and a grown oak tree.
- Look for oak tree leaves and birds’ nests in the trees like we saw in the story.
